Credit for Non-Classroom Courses and Activities

J.D. students may take a maximum of 18 credits in courses or approved law school activities that do not meet in the classroom for traditional coursework. Examples of courses and activities included under the 18-credit limit include Moot Court, Mock Trial, Journals, the *non-classroom portion* of Externships, Directed Research, Directed Study, and Practicums in which students are required to do work outside of the traditional classroom setting. They do **not** include approved experiential courses that are taught in a classroom setting such as ADR, Negotiation, Doing Deals, and Clinics.
