The Department of Accessibility Services (DAS), part of the Office of Institutional Equity and Compliance, determines if a student is qualified for disability accommodation support and determines the scope of those accommodations. DAS provides reasonable accommodations to ensure equal access to law school programs and bases their determinations on medical documentation. DAS makes the determination for both classroom and testing accommodation. Confidentiality is honored and maintained at all times by DAS. Once approved by DAS, students must submit the accommodation letter with classes listed to the law school Registrar by the announced deadline in order to ensure that they receive any testing accommodations. Students are required to request classroom and testing accommodations each semester and for every course in which they plan on accessing their accommodation(s). Any appeal about the qualification of a student or the accommodation(s) provided is processed by the DAS office in accordance with their policies.
