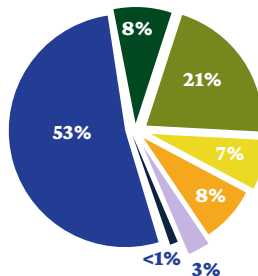

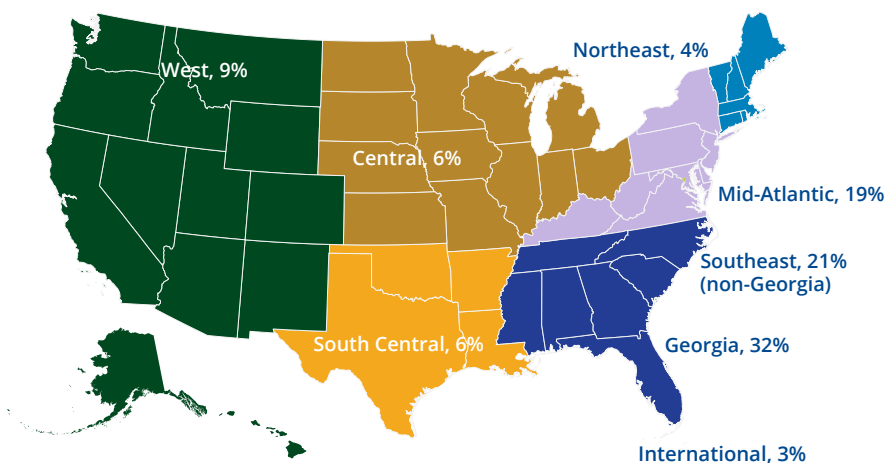

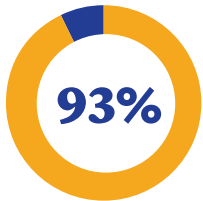
LIFE ON CAMPUS

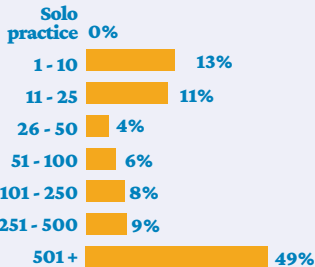

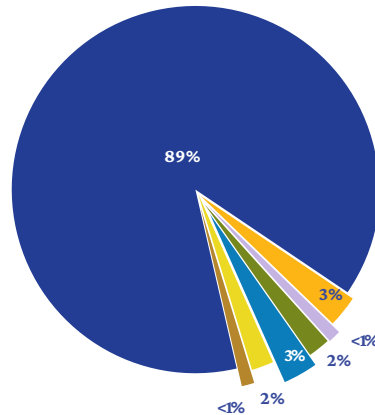

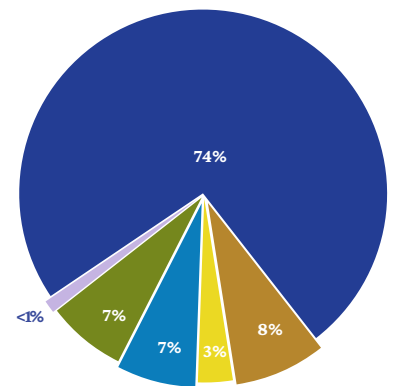

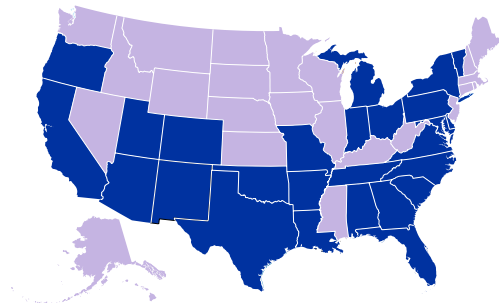
