Mr. Elliott received both his B.A. and J.D. degrees from Emory University. For 30 years he was a partner at Alston and Bird in Atlanta, Georgia and since 1996 has been the Associate Dean at Emory University Law School teaching Legal Profession, Finance and Banking.

He is a past president of the State Bar of Georgia and its Younger Lawyer Division and of the Old War Horse Lawyers Club and is a past Chair of the Georgia Institute of Continuing Education.

He is the developer of the ABA Gambrell award-winning program for the teaching of Ethics and Professionalism. He is a Fellow of the American Bar Foundation, the Georgia Bar Foundation and the American College of Real Estate lawyers.

He is a co-founder of Georgia Legal Services, which has provided legal help to hundreds of thousands of poor Georgians and of Georgia's IOLTA Program which has raised over \$100,000,000 for legal/charitable causes.
